## **ORDER**

AND NOW, this 11th day of December, 2019, upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion to Set Class Discovery Deadlines and Approve Class Notice under Pa.R.C.P. 1712 ("Plaintiffs' Motion"), and any response thereto, it is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED, as follows:

- 2. Class counsel are authorized to retain RG2 Claims Administration, LLC, to assist in administration of class notice.
- 3. No later than <u>January 15, 2020</u> Plaintiffs shall send, by first class mail, and also by e-mail to any last known e-mail address, a copy of the class notice to each class member.
- 4. Individuals who wish to opt out of the Class shall submit a written "Request to Opt Out," as set forth in the Notice. The Request to Opt Out must be sent by email or regular mail within sixty (60) days of the date of the Notice. An individual who submits a valid and timely Request to Opt Out shall not be bound by or receive relief from any order, judgment, or settlement entered or approved by this Court. Plaintiffs shall log each Request to Opt Out and provide copies of the log to Defendant as soon as practicable after the time to opt out has expired.
- 5. Any Class Member who does not properly and timely submit a Request to Opt Out, pursuant to the Notice, shall be automatically included in the Class and shall be bound by any order, judgment, or settlement entered or approved by this Court, whether or not such Class Member received actual notice.
- 6. Plaintiffs' counsel shall pay the costs of the foregoing notice, subject to their right to recover the cost at the successful conclusion of this action.

7. Trial discovery shall commence immediately, and shall be concluded

by February 3, 2020
